# Day One

## The Meaning of a New Moon Solar Eclipse

**Theme:** Ancient wisdom, fear, and reverence

Before astrology became modernized, eclipses were approached with caution, humility, and respect. Many ancient cultures believed eclipses temporarily disrupted the natural order—veils thinned, kings fell, destinies shifted, and hidden truths emerged. People were advised not to look at the eclipse, and replacement kings would be substituted to protect the king.

### Reflection & Study


Notice the common thread: eclipses were not times to “do more,” but to pause and observe. What was the true role of superstition during ancient times? How can modern knowledge help us to approach eclipses without fear? For instance, we now know how to protect our eyes.

### Journal Prompts

- What does a solar eclipse stir in me—excitement, awe, fear, discomfort?
- What am I afraid might change if I let go of control?
- Where in my life do I sense an ending or an irreversible shift?

### Spiritual Insight

Fear often arises at the edge of transformation. Today is not about fixing fear—only witnessing it.



# Day Two

## Beyond Intention Setting

**Theme:** Allowing instead of initiating

Most New Moons are associated with intention setting and conscious manifestation. A solar eclipse, however, operates differently. It carries a sense of fated momentum—events unfold whether we push or not.

### Reflection Practice

Notice impulses to “decide,” “announce,” or “act.”

Resist the urge to force clarity.

### Journal Prompts

- What do I feel tempted to act on right now?
- What if I allowed events to flow instead of directing them?
- Where might patience serve me better than action?

### Spiritual Insight

This eclipse asks for alignment, not assertion.



# Day Three

## Witnessing the Eclipse

**Theme:** Totality, presence, and embodiment

There is a profound difference between hearing about an eclipse and standing beneath one. Those who experience totality often describe it as otherworldly—time stretches, the body reacts, emotions surface unexpectedly.

### Practical Preparation

Make sure you have certified, approved eclipse viewing glasses. Learn how to use them properly: glasses stay on at all times except during totality, if you are within the path. Practice removing and replacing them calmly.


### Body Preparation

Consider how you want your body to feel on eclipse day. You may choose to:

- Reduce caffeine or heavy foods
- Eat more simply
- Hydrate intentionally
- Rest more than usual

### Journal Prompts

How does my body respond to awe or intensity?  
What does my nervous system need to feel safe and present?



# Day Four

## Your Natal Chart & Eclipse Activation

Theme: Personal astrology and place-based awareness

Every eclipse lands somewhere in your natal chart, activating a specific life area. Understanding this helps you contextualize what may shift internally or externally.

Reflection. Identify:

- The house and sign of the eclipse in your natal chart
- Any close aspects to personal planets

If travelling, consider astrocartography: eclipse lines may amplify experiences depending on location.

Free Ways to Explore. Many astrology platforms allow eclipse overlays at no cost.

- Use free chart calculators online (natal charts, transits, astrocartography maps - (check the resources page)

Journal Prompts

- Which life themes are highlighted for me now?
- How might location influence my eclipse experience?



# Day Five

## Interpreting This Eclipse

**Theme:** Meaning, symbolism, and personal narrative

Each eclipse carries a unique message shaped by its sign, degree, planetary rulers, and aspects.

### Study & Reflection

Explore interpretations of this specific eclipse.



### Journal Prompts

- What feels ready to close—or quietly begin?

### Spiritual Insight

# Day Six

## Travel & Practical Readiness

**Theme:** Conscious preparation

If you are traveling to experience the eclipse, today is about grounding logistics so your mind can stay present.

### Checklist


- Eclipse glasses (packed and accessible)
- Journal and pen
- Camera or phone (with eclipse-safe filters if applicable)
- Weather-appropriate clothing
- Water and snacks
- Photography Safety

Never photograph the sun without proper solar filters.  
Practice ahead of time.

If in totality, rehearse removing filters only during that brief window.

### Journal Prompt

What does being “prepared” feel like emotionally, not just practically?



# Day Seven

## Eclipse Day

**Theme:** Presence, release, and trust  
Today is not about expectation—it is about witnessing.

### If the Sky Is Clear

Stay present.  
Observe emotional, physical, and mental responses.  
Avoid making major declarations or decisions.

### If It's Cloudy

Remember: the eclipse is still happening.  
Use the day for meditation, journaling, or quiet contemplation.  
Reflect on the symbolism of obscured vision and unseen change.

### Closing Reflection

- What did I experience, regardless of visibility?
- What feels altered, even subtly?

### Affirmation

I trust what unfolds beyond my control.

### Integration Note

Eclipse energy continues to unfold for weeks and even months. Return to your journal often. Clarity arrives gradually.



# HOW TO USE THE MAPS

Experiencing an eclipse is pure wonder! Experiencing eclipse totality is transcendent. The ancients feared viewing the solar eclipse and advised to stay indoors and not look. Today, we know more about eclipses and how they operate and can predict them with accuracy. The astrology will dictate how an eclipse will play out. Some eclipses are stronger than others. South Node eclipses generally bring karmic experiences, while North Node eclipses tend to be gentler. However, the connection and configuration to other planets will also dictate how difficult or smooth an eclipse will be.

Total - those eclipse path (the red line on the map) will experience darkness

Annular - the moon is farther from the Earth; it appears smaller and leaves a ring of light around the eclipse. The best place to experience the eclipse is a location along the yellow line on the map

Partial - the sun and moon are not perfectly aligned, but the moon still covers part of the sun

This booklet provides the solar eclipse paths for eclipses up until 2030. Some eclipses do not produce totality (complete darkness), however, eclipses with totality are maps that are shaded brown and have listed some cities that will experience eclipse totality.


Locations that are great for experiencing the eclipse have been zoomed in on, and you can find a link in the resource page at the end to zoom into locations further.




Also, each chart has been rated in terms of its difficulty. Green is easy, and red is difficult

The Astrology charts are provided to show the configuration of the planets. If you know a lot about astrology, then they will help you to interpret the eclipse. If you don't know astrology, no problem. As the eclipse comes close, I will be writing about the eclipse and what you can expect on my site and [Substack](#). If you are serious about travelling to one of these locations during an eclipse, knowing your personal localization lines will help you understand what you may experience.
